The document released under FOI 4334 contains a list of batch numbers and 'dose in series' for suspected adverse events in people who received a COVID-19 vaccine. Dose in series is the reported location in an order or sequence for when the dose was administered, for example if it was the first, second or third dose of a COVID-19 vaccine received. The quality and completeness of the information is dependent on the data provided by the reporter.

The file contains one data row for each distinct report associated with a suspected/interacting COVID-19 vaccine in an accepted adverse event case created between 8 November 2022 and 30 March 2023 where the outcome of the adverse event was reported as fatal. Some adverse event reports provide dose number and batch number for multiple COVID-19 vaccine doses. Where more than one dose was included in a case the information for any additional doses and associated batch numbers is provided in adjacent columns.

Since the beginning of the vaccine rollout to 2 April 2023, almost 66 million doses of COVID-19 vaccines have been given in Australia. The TGA has identified 14 reports where the cause of death was linked to vaccination from 983 reports received and reviewed.
