<u>Therapeutic Goods Act 1989</u> <u>Approval under section 42DF for use of restricted representations by</u> <u>Bayer Australia Limited</u>

I, Leanne McCauley, Delegate of the Secretary to the Department of Health, on receipt of an application from Bayer Australia Limited, have approved under section 42DF of the *Therapeutic Goods Act 1989*, the use of the below stated restricted representations in advertisements directed to consumers, for the following medicines:

CITRICAL CALCIUM CITRATE (AUST L 325772) and CITRICAL PLUS D (AUST L 325774)

a) A diet deficient in calcium can lead to osteoporosis in later life. Calcium may help to prevent osteoporosis when dietary intake is inadequate.

CITRICAL PLUS D (AUST L 325774)

b) Vitamin D helps calcium absorption (or words of like intent) and a diet deficient in calcium can lead to osteoporosis later in life.
