Therapeutic Goods Act 1989
Approval under section 42DF for use of restricted representations by
DJO Global Pty Ltd

I, Leanne McCauley, as a delegate of the Secretary to the Department of Health, on receipt of an application from DJO Global Pty Ltd have approved under section 42DF of the *Therapeutic Goods Act 1989* (the **Act**) the restricted representations described in paragraph **(A)** below only for use in consumer advertising of the products identified in paragraph **(B)**:

- *Donjoy OA bracing range offers relief of unicompartmental osteoarthritis symptoms whilst being worn*, which will always be accompanied by a statement, prominently displayed or communicated,¹ to the effect that “your healthcare professional will determine whether this product is right for you”.
- Representations referring to “*Osteoarthritis*” and/or “*OA*” in the context of stating the product names including:
 - *OA Adjuster 3*
 - *Clima Flex OA*
 - *OA Nano*
 - *OA Full Force*
 - *OA Reaction*
