## <u>Therapeutic Goods Act 1989</u> <u>Approval under section 42DF for use of restricted representations by</u> <u>Ossur Australia Pty Ltd</u>

I, Rowena Love, Delegate of the Secretary to the Department of Health, on receipt of an application from Ossur Australia Pty Ltd, have approved under section 42DF of the *Therapeutic Goods Act 1989* (the Act) the restricted representations described in paragraph (a) (i) – (ii) below for use in advertisements directed to consumers, for the product identified in paragraph (b):

a) (i) Representations which refer to "osteoarthritis" to the effect of providing accurate, balanced and contemporary information, the purpose of which is to inform consumers of the description of the disease; and

(ii) Representations which refer to "osteoarthritis" to the effect that the use of the devices may:

- provide symptomatic relief of knee osteoarthritis by bracing and/or supporting and/or stabilising and/or unloading the knee\*
- relieve joint pain associated with knee osteoarthritis by bracing and/or supporting and/or stabilising and/or unloading the knee\*
- improve knee joint function associated with osteoarthritis by bracing and/or supporting and/or stabilising and/or unloading the knee\*

\*while being worn (with the words 'while being worn' prominently displayed or communicated i.e. standing out so as to be easily read from a normal viewing distance and/or heard and understood).

b) "Orthosis, leg, knee unit (unloading knee braces)" (ARTG No. 135047)
