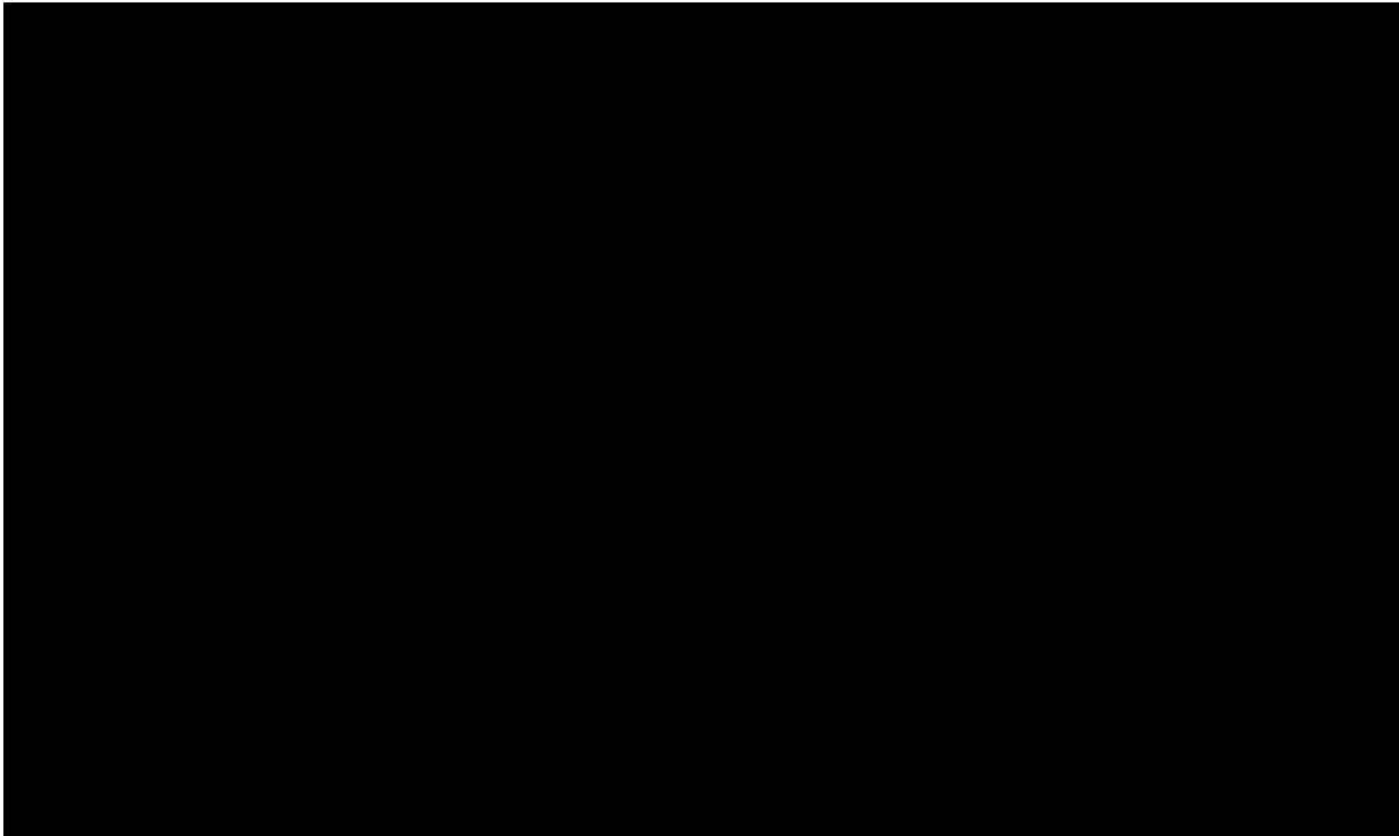

10.2 Vaccine reports

During the 6-week period from 1 July to 15 August 2007 [redacted]

83 of the reports related to HPV vaccine (Gardasil). Virtually all of the Gardasil reports are for teenaged girls given the vaccine via school-based programs. [redacted]
