
10.2 Vaccine reports

During the 6-week period from 1 July to 15 August 2007

83 of the reports related to HPV vaccine (Gardasil). Virtually all of the Gardasil reports are for teenaged girls given the vaccine via school-based programs.

Members' attention was also drawn to 2 reports of syncope that were treated with adrenaline. The Committee agreed it was wise to err on the side of caution in situations such as this.
