

10.2 Vaccine reports

During the 6-week period from 1 April to 15 May 2006, 167 reports of vaccine adverse reactions were lodged. This represents 12.9% of the reports lodged for the period.



About 45% of the reports were received from States, Territories or Local Government Shire Councils; 47% were received from health professionals; 14 reports were received from sponsors, and 2 were from the Australian Vaccination Network.
