1 Name

This instrument is the *Therapeutic Goods (Provisional and Priority Determinations and Orphan Drug Designations) Approval of Application Form.*

2 Definitions

In this instrument:

Act means the Therapeutic Goods Act 1989.

orphan drug designation means a designation under regulation 16J of the Regulations.

provisional determination means a determination under section 22D of the Act.

Regulations means the *Therapeutic Goods Regulations* 1990.

TGA means the part of the Department of Health known as the Therapeutic Goods Administration.

therapeutic goods (priority applicant) determination has the meaning given by section 25AAA of the Act.

3 Applications to which this instrument applies

This instrument applies to the following applications:

- (a) an application under section 22C of the Act for a provisional determination;
- (b) an application under regulation 16H of the Regulations for an orphan drug designation;
- (c) an application under regulation 16Q of the Regulations for a therapeutic goods (priority applicant) determination.

4 Approved form

The approved form for an application to which this instrument applies is the online form titled *Prescription Medicines – Designation/Determination Application* in the TGA's electronic lodgement facility, completed in accordance with the relevant instructions in that form.
