restricted representation means a representation referred to in section 42DD of the Act.

specified goods means a registered medicine, other than a prescription medicine, that:

- (a) contains:
 - (i) 0.3 mg/0.3 mL adrenaline (epinephrine); or
 - (ii) 0.15 mg/0.3 mL adrenaline (epinephrine);

as the only active ingredient; and

- (b) is in the form of an auto-injector, or pre-filled syring, sund administration; and
- (c) has an indication accepted in relation to inclusi in relates the emergency treatment of anaphylaxis.

5 Permission
