I am a conventional veterinary surgeon who uses homeopathic medicines as part of my normal treatment of animals large and small under my care. We use conventional drugs in our daily work as well, and these medicines just give us extra options.

They seem to work very well, even though they are diluted medicines, and even though the NHMRC review found otherwise. I have had several cases that were deemed incurable by conventional therapy that have been cured using these medicines.
