1 Name

3 Authority

This instrument is made under subsections 42DK(3) and 42DK(4) of the *Therapeutic Goods Act 1989*.

4 Definitions

Act means *Therapeutic Goods Act 1989*.

Commonwealth health campaign means a campaign about a public health matter that is conducted, approved or funded by the Commonwealth.

prohibited representation has the same meaning as in subsection 42DJ(1) of the Act.

5 Permission

For subsections 42DK(3) and 42DK(4) of the Act, in relation to each item, the prohibited representations specified in column 2 of the table in Schedule 1 to this instrument are permitted to be used in an advertisement specified in column 3 of the table about the therapeutic goods specified in column 4 of the table, subject to the conditions (if any) specified in column 5 of the table.
