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1 Name

This instrument is the *Therapeutic Goods (Prohibited Representations—Condoms and Sunscreens) Permission 2019.*

2 Commencement

(1) Each provision of this instrument specified in column 1 of the table commences, or is taken to have commenced, in accordance with column 2 of the table. Any other statement in column 2 has effect according to its terms.

3 Authority

This instrument is made under subsections 42DK(2) and 42DK(3) of the *Therapeutic Goods Act 1989*.

4 Definitions

Note:

- (c) listed goods:
- (d) registered goods; and
- (e) therapeutic goods.

In this instrument:

Act means Therapeutic Goods Act 1989.

AS/NSZ 2604:2012 means the document, Australian/New Zealand Standard: Sunscreen products – Evaluation and classification (AS/NZS 2604:2012), prepared by the Joint Technical Committee CS-042 (Sunscreen Agents), approved on behalf of the Council of Standards Australia on 9 May 2012 and the Council of Standards New Zealand on 9 May 2012, and published by SAI Global

Limited under licence from Standards Australia on 30 May 2012, as in force or existing immediately before the commencement of this instrument.

Note: Section 2B of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901* defines Standards Australia.

prohibited representation has the same meaning as in subsection 42DJ(1) of the Act.

sun protection factor has the same meaning as in AS/NZS 2604:2012.

5 Permission

For subsections 42DK(2) and 42DK(3) of the Act, in relation to each item, the prohibited representations specified in column 2 of the table in Schedule 1 to this instrument are permitted to be used in an advertisement specified in column 3 of the table, about the therapeutic goods specified in column 4 of the table, subject to the conditions (if any) specified in column 5 of the table.

6 Repeals

Each instrument that is specified in Schedule 2 to this instrument is repealed as set out in the applicable items in that Schedule.
