In this instrument:

Act means the Therapeutic Goods Act 1989.

Regulations means the Therapeutic Goods Regulations 1990.

relevant sponsor means a sponsor of therapeutic goods in relation to which any of the following applies:

- (a) an exemption under section 18, 32CA or 41HA of the Act;
- (b) an approval under section 19, 32CK or 41HB of the Act;
- (c) an authority under section 19, 32CM or 41HC of the Act.

Therapeutic Goods Administration means that Part of the Department known as the Therapeutic Goods Administration.

5 Approved form

The approved form for providing a report to the Secretary by a relevant sponsor under paragraph 47B(1)(c) of the Regulations is the form titled *Six monthly report – supply of unapproved therapeutic goods by a sponsor* (March 2022) published on the Therapeutic Goods Administration website.
